



Thank you so very much for your prayers and encouragement as I travelled to Asia. We're so grateful for your support offered through friendship, prayers and generosity. It's such an encouragement. Thanks for your partnership with us!

After being gone for more than three weeks, I returned the end of May from teaching in China to complete the last month of the School of Biblical Studies (SBS) in Kona, the program with which I serve. It's such a privilege to serve in this way, and Dennis and I agree that life is full and fulfilling.

I had a great trip to China, with meaningful experiences with the students and workers there. Thanks so much for your participation in what God is doing in their lives and in that nation! I taught Romans and Revelation in the Bible Core Course in one city, and then visited the city where our daughter and her family live (yay for family visits!) and met with their team, too.

We finished the last week of SBS before our graduation celebration last week on Tuesday evening (see photo above). This nine month school went fast, as fast as previous ones have gone, and I'm going to miss all our students. I'm really happy that our whole staff team will be back again for the next school which begins the end of September. This has been such a great team to serve with, and I'll miss them all as we go our various ways over the summer.

Two days after graduation, we sent two outreach teams to teach the Bible, one to Samoa and one to India. Later, we'll send another team to China. Our graduated students are now teaching how to study the Bible, an overview of the Bible, and various books of the Bible. After nine months of studying the Bible, they've had a privilege that many others haven't had. Now they're taking their responsibility seriously and sharing what they've learned with others. We're looking forward to hearing how their efforts bear fruit in the lives of many people.

This summer, Lord willing, I'll teach in the Discipleship Bible School in Samoa for a week, and then in the Solomon Islands for a week. I'll fit in family visits on the mainland after that, and then go to Australia to teach in YWAM Perth's Bible Core Course.

I'm leaving July 20, and when you think of it, you can pray for that trip, please. In both Samoa and the Solomon Islands, we're training local leaders to teach and lead Bible programs so that their students will be able to teach and disciple others. My part will be to take a week in each of the two schools to cover Joshua, Judges, Ruth and the Psalms. In Australia, I'll serve the students and staff of their Bible school as we work our way through Hebrews and Revelation. In addition, I still need about \$3000 to cover the trip.

Dennis and I are both committed to multiplying what God has given us as we invest in others, and we're so grateful for your partnership in this ministry. Your investment in our students in Kona and around the world is bearing much lasting fruit. Thanks so much! And may you continue to experience God's wonderful presence and his great grace each day.
